Additional hiring events will be scheduled.

Eligible candidates may include dislocated workers, low income adults or young adults not connected to work or school. On-the-Job training and work experience/internships for those impacted by COVID should complete before the end of 2020. Disaster relief and humanitarian jobs may go to June 2021.
