












Job Type: Full-time Responsibilities:

- Perform inspection of dimensional, layout, assemblies, and fixtures or gauges using a CMM (Coordinate Measuring Machine) or other appropriate measuring devices. Examples include but are not limited to, hole locations, contour measurements, and shapes conforming within prescribed tolerances to print specifications using CMM.
- Inspect the first piece, in-process, and finished products, including the first article, by conducting visual and measurement tests, setting up and running CMMs to perform inspection processes, documenting and communicating required corrections, and ensuring the defective product is not delivered to the customer.
- Process and store CMM or manual inspection data in electronic and printed formats (IAW) with internal standard work
- Ensure that standard procedures are followed in all aspects of work, ensuring documentation is accurate and complete (i.e., Traveler Sign-off).
- Provide training in using the CMM and inspection instruments, as needed.
- (Additional Responsibilities.)

#### **Public Health Nurse**

Position Location: New Haven, CT, USA

Job Type: Full-time **Responsibilities:** 

- Implementing program objectives.
- Collecting data regarding the health and developmental status of the individual.
- Identifying and evaluating individual chronic health needs and referring as appropriate.
- Assessing and making referrals for injuries (including first aid) and acute illnesses.
- Coordinating and implementing mandated screening tests.
- Discussing and counseling students and parents/guardians on findings and implications of health assessments/screenings.
- Administering medication and providing specialized physical health care procedures as prescribed.

**Room Attendant** 

Position Location: New Haven, CT, USA

**Job Type:** Full-time **Responsibilities:** 

- Keep assigned carts and closets well organized.
- Document time in and out of each room.
- Punch in the updated room status of each room.
- Clean rooms to hotel standards, ensuring each room is complete and ready for a guest and/or VIP to occupy.
- Help other room Attendants when asked by the supervisor.

**Assistant Property Manager** 

Position Location: New Haven, CT, USA

**Job Type:** Full-time **Responsibilities:** 

- The role of the Assistant Property Manager is to assist the Property Manager with the routine operation of the mixedfinance portfolio property.
- Perform inspections of units to ensure compliance with Housing Quality Standards (HQS) and Uniform Physical Conditions Standards (UPCS).
- Prepare leases for applicants and provide applicants with the necessary documents and materials.
- Track evictions by maintaining contact with the company's local attorney.
- (Additional Responsibilities.)

**Finance Specialist** 

Position Location: Meriden, CT, USA

Job Type: Full-time **Responsibilities:** 

- Reconcile monthly bank statements to accounting records using financial system data.
- Responsible for maintaining and balancing the monthly premium charges from life and medical insurance policies for employees and retirees, including determining eligibility, making membership changes, and preparing invoices for payment.
- Responsible for maintaining records and collecting and depositing payments received from employees who self-pay.
- Responsible for verifying and attaching daily bank receipts to all incoming cash transmittals, batching all transmittals by date, assigning voucher numbers, entering transmittals computer occasionally, balancing, and posting.
- Prepares daily bank deposits on an alternating basis with other office employees. Responsible for verifying and attaching daily bank receipts to all incoming cash transmittals, batches all transmittals by date and assigns voucher numbers, enters transmittals in the computer, balances, and posts.
- Enter journal entries into the financial system.

**BDS Machine Operator (2nd shift)** 

Position Location: Deep River, CT, USA

Job Type: Full-time **Responsibilities:** 

- Starts up and operates BDS (plastic blow molding) machines, RSTs, & auxiliary equipment as needed.
- Inspects products and makes adjustments to machines to meet quality and production standards.
- Keep the production floor clean of tails, moils, pellets, bottles, and any material, e.g., regrind.
- Other duties as assigned by the supervisor
- Must be able to lift 50 lb. bags of resin/concentrate into the blender. Must be able to climb ladders and stand on your feet all shift.

#### **Behavioral Specialist**

Position Location: North Haven, CT, USA

**Job Type:** Full-time **Responsibilities:** 

- Develop behavior support plans that will assist individuals in being successful in their employment and community activities.
- Provide training and support to program staff regarding the implementation of behavior support plans, including on-site support and crisis intervention, as necessary.
- Implement behavioral data analysis forms or data collection methodologies, analyze behavioral data, and complete summary reports.

#### **CNC Machinist**

**Location:** Enfield, CT, USA **Employment Type:** Full-time

#### **Responsibilities:**

- Ability to set up, troubleshoot, and operate CNC Machines.
- Inspect work completed on CNC Machines for conformance to specifications using bench gauging.
- Strictly follow Standard Work in all aspects of work including CNC Machine setup and operation, process verification, product inspection, documentation, and material handling.
- Perform light preventative maintenance tasks on CNC Machines to maintain machinery performance and prevent machine
  downtime.
- Reports any safety violation, machining equipment misusage, and/or improperly performed work to the supervisor may provide input for action, including discipline.

#### **Multimedia and Marketing Associate**

Location: West Haven, CT, USA

### **Job Type:** Full-time **Responsibilities:**

- Creation of content for social media platforms and other advertorial media.
- Assist with the development of marketing strategies and campaigns across various channels, including social media, website content, and occasionally print media.
- Assist in managing, organizing, and procuring marketing assets such as product renderings, application photography, videography, etc.
- Monitor and report on basic website analytics using tools such as Google Analytics.
- Assist in organizing and coordinating travel, events, or sales workshops.

#### **Inside Sales and Customer Service Representative**

**Job Type:** Full-time **Responsibilities:** 

- Act as the main conduit for customer communications.
- Determine and understand customer requirements and communicate those customer requirements throughout the organization.
- Respond to requests for customer quotations, follow up on quotes, and enter orders resulting from quotes.
- Review orders entered by other Sales Representatives for accuracy.
- Respond to customer requests for expedites. Communicate order status to customer.
