

Position Location: Wallingford, CT, USA

Job Type: Full-time **Responsibilities:**

- Supervise the campus, both inside (classrooms, bathrooms, gymnasium, auditorium, etc.) and outside (parking lot, entrances, school grounds, etc.) of the building.
- Notify administrative staff of any unusual issues or concerns as they arise.
- Contact the main office or 911 in the event of an emergency.
- Direct visitors regarding how to access services and personnel within the building.
- Supervise students passing through the assigned area in a limited capacity.
- Checks locked classrooms and windows throughout the building.
- Monitor the security cameras.
- Monitor and provide assistance during school events.
- Any other necessary duties to aid in the functioning of the building.

Job Type: Full-time **Responsibilities:**

- In coordination with other teachers, plan, supervise, and implement an infant/toddler curriculum that is reflective of Quaker values and guided by children's interests and developmental needs.
