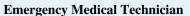


Picker/ Packer

Position Location: Orange, CT, USA

**Job Type:** Full-time **Responsibilities:** 

- Responsible for the selection of merchandise and preparing them for outbound shipment.
- Operate with a strong attention to detail, you will read pick tickets, prioritizing most critical orders, verifying items picked, then match the pick tickets.
- Send all picked orders to the packing department after verifying all items are free of defects or damage. Afterward, move the completed orders to appropriate shipment locations.
- Pack goods following a specific set of instructions and procedures, properly sealing, and labeling all shipments.
- Positive and can- do attitude. Punctuality is a must.

**Job Type:** Full-time **Responsibilities:** 

- Provide an assessment of patients, determine necessary care and deliver emergency services by utilizing appropriate medical techniques and equipment. Collaborate with public safety, and other EMT effectively.

- May help facilitate educational focus groups and activities within the treatment facility.

**Job Type:** Full-time **Responsibilities:** 

- Assist teachers and parents in assessing student progress with behavior management systems.
- Adapt classroom activities, assignments and/or materials under the direction of the supervising teacher for the purpose of supporting and reinforcing classroom objectives and meeting IEP goals.
- Communicates with supervising instructional staff, and a variety of health care professionals, and professional support personnel for the purpose of communicating progress or implementing IEP objectives.
- Knowledge and ability to safely support students' physical needs such as lifting, repositioning, feeding, and toileting.
- Actively participate in ongoing professional development opportunities and training.
